### **Patient Dress Code**

DAPC recognizes that dress can play an important part in how one feels about one's self and others. It can also play an important role in maintaining order and discipline. Therefore, the residential patients will comply with the following dress code:

1. No alcohol, tavern or drug logo shirts, caps, or jackets. This applies to staff, graduates and patients. Patients are responsible to see that their visitors comply with this rule.
2. No one is allowed on the main floor unless fully dresses. Shirts must be buttoned and midriffs covered. No one is allowed into group or chow hall in robes or pajama's.
3. Shorts must be decent length to provide full coverage and must not be full of holes.
4. Anyone not meeting these basic requirements will be sent to change into appropriate clothing by the house leader or staff. Further more, staff on duty reserve the right to send someone to change if they determine that the clothing is inappropriate or distracting to the functioning of the house.
