The following list is intended to assist you in easy preparation and a smooth transition into treatment

Personal hygiene products: (must be new/unopened or will be confiscated)

1. Toothbrush
2. Toothpaste
3. Deodorant
4. Shampoo
5. Conditioner
6. Soap/Body wash

ALCOHOL IN PRODUCT INGREDIENTS CAN NOT BE IN THE FIRST FOUR INGREDIENTS LISTED

Personal Clothing items:

1. Shoes (walking shoes)
2. Slippers (something must be on feet at all times)
3. Socks
4. Pajama's/sleep wear
5. Winter coat
6. Light jacket or sweater
7. Enough indoor clothing to last a week between laundry
8. All Clothing items needed for baby/child if they are with you

Other personal effects allowed:

1. Phone cards (patients require one for direct calls outside local area)
2. Stamps
3. Alarm Clock
4. CD player/radio (w/headphones)

Items needed for baby:

1. Diapers
2. Formula
3. Bottles
4. Clothing-enough for 2 weeks (14 jammies, 14 outfits)
5. Stroller
6. Car seat
7. Small toys

Any medication you are currently taking as prescribed, must be in the original bottle with the prescription label attached. Also, any Over the Counter medication that you need, (Ibuprofen, Tylenol, Medicated Foot Cream, ect), must be ok'd in writing by your doctor before you will be allowed to use them.

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED: NO TABACCO PRODUCTS, no sugar, no cell phones, no cameras, no perfume/cologne, no weapons, and no drugs of paraphernalia of any kind.
